### Coach Gaz Harrison Interview

This is your first season coaching Worcester Wolves U13s how do you feel it s going?

Having taken over the team knowing last year they had only won two games was a challenge to begin with. However, I was pleasantly surprised at how much potential they had. Most of this comes down to they are now the right age for the league they re in. I feel it s going really well and I m excited for the last three games.

Your team are currently riding high in the U13 West Division what have you been doing in training that has benefitted you in your games?

In training we ve really focused on team work and help defence. These two things go hand in hand. If you have a team that works together it makes the communication for help defence easier and stronger.

You have three games left before the end of the season; Frankley Falcons, West Brom and Shrewsbury. Are you working on anything in training to win these games?

We've played two out of the three teams already so we will be adapting training to help with our strategy to beat them. I can t tell you what that is... coaches secret!

Having fourteen dif erent personalities has been really hard, some are easier to develop and work with than others. However, I have enjoyed the challenge. Getting all parents on board understanding their own children's roles within the team has also been a good challenge, we have worked well together to make it an enjoyable year for all the kids.

What do you do to bring out the best results from your team during a game.

Game coaching is my strength. As a player I can read what's happening in the game fairly well. I just ask my players to believe in me and my decisions and execute what I ask of them.

Do you have any advice for a new coach looking to bring a team to the YBL next season.

Yes! Bring them over to the league. This is the best league around for player development. We ve had games where I ve had to play my stronger players for the majority, but also had games where the less experienced players can get some more valuable game time. There is a real spread of ability and that s what I like the most. Also, for any new coach they will have the full support of the league and quite often get help with referees and coaching courses.

Do you have any memorable games/highlights from your frst season.

There's been so many it's hard to name just a few. The full game battle against Bromsgrove Bears was a team changing experience for us as we had to dig deep all 40 minutes. Where we had beaten them by 20 points odd in the frst game, but only two the second time around. Playing against Spartans last weekend was great as both me and Matt Coles [their coach] agreed to put on our fve youngest and less experienced players and let them f nish the game. This shows that even other teams want all players in the league to get a chance to develop even if they re not theirs!

Finally, we have heard at YBL HQ that you warm up to Dancing Queen is that correct?

'Dancing Queen' is one of many songs that we warm up to. Other noted songs are 'Believe' by Cher and 'Eye of the Tiger'.


