Get the most out of the YBL The YBL is shaping up nicely and as a result our web site is continuing to grow with content supplied by our clubs.

We have several sections that you will find helpful, such as: The Downloads Page, where you can view and download the League Rules (2014 version), the latest and back issues of Youth Basketball News and YBL Forms. Recently added are the YBL Scoresheet, designed for beginners to table officiating, as the boxes are bigger for you to write in. A Game Card, where club team managers or coaches can fill in for when they go to away games. It looks professional and it saves time when you get there! You can also download the Expenses Form for when you go and officiate other clubs games. We missed anything?

The Fixtures and Results section is packed with useful information. You can check upcoming fixtures and previous results for each league game. Competent and qualified table officials are an important requirement for all basketball games. Table officials are trained and assessed through courses and examinations during the officiating courses.

Level 1

This award is an introduction to basketball and is aimed at the pure beginner. It gives an insight into the basic work of a timekeeper and scorer at a basketball game. A Level 1 table official is qualified to officiate at school matches, central venue and local league (youth leagues) and recreational level basketball. DEADI

Great Briton Under 20 Women Roster Announced Source: EB

British Basketball has announced the final team for the Division B FIBA Europe U20 Women's Championship commencing on Thursday, 3 July in Sofia, Bulgaria.

The selection was made after a limited but intense five-day preparation at the University of Essex where Head coach Peter Buckle has been impressed with the team's training camp set-up:

"It's been a good opportunity to see the progress of the GB U20s as the next generation of senior players. We have worked hard on building the GB style of basketball with the future in mind and I look forward to the tournament games as our next stage of development."

Six players of last year's team, including senior team player, Harriet Ottewill-Soulsby have returned to form the core of the squad. Harriet will be re-joined by Shequila Joseph, Melita Emanuel-Carr, Cheridene Green, Whitney Allen and Megan Lewis as a group who will be looking to improve on last year's eighth placed finish.

With an eye on the future, the team features nine players who will be eligible again for the U20s in 2015. National Team Director Warwick Cann commented: "This has been a very testing preparation but the staff and players have come together very well and are up for the challenge of a full round robin of nine games.

"Having one of our leading senior players, Azania Stewart, into camp to talk with the U20 team has also been a great initiative to build our hardworking culture and aid player understanding.

"I am extremely grateful of the staff that have worked together at late notice and volunteered their time to help GB basketball be successful."

U18 Women end Portugal Trip with another loss Source:E

Georgia Gayle's 17 points were not enough to prevent the U18 Women ending their three game trip to Portugal with an 80-51 loss to their hosts.

England started slowly and were down by 16 points midway through the second period, but Lee Ryan's side rallied to cut the deficit to 40-28 going into the locker room at half-time.

A 14-3 run from the home side to open the second half effectively ended the chances of a comeback, but England's defence stepped and they scored nine unanswered points in the final minutes of the third period and cut the lead to 58-38 at the last break.

At 67-51 down late on the game was as good as gone and then Portugal scored the last 13 points of the game to give the scoreline a more lopsided look.

Victoria Grey added 12 points for England, while Melanie George finished with a double-double as she hit ten points and pulled down as many boards.

Coach Lee Ryan commented: "We came to Portugal to play these games to expose this group to a high level and that's exactly what we got."

"We step on the floor with high energy every game, but we need to maintain our concentration for 40 minutes. Teams at this level will punish you for lapses, so it is up to the players to be disciplined in our approach.

"This series gave us the chance to experiment and find out what we can do, at times we played some really strong team basketball, we now have a home camp followed by two games in Finland to become consistent.

"This team is a collective and remains together. I think this Portugal trip will be a moment we look back on as a turning point later this summer."
