## Fixtures & Rearrangements

Last day to register a new player for the regular season. Thursday 29 February 2024

Fixture Dates - 2023/2024 Season

Fixtures Issued on or before. Rearrangement Deadline Opening Weekend End of the regular Season.

#### Rearrangement before the Rearrangement Deadline

Rearrangements will be permitted free of charge with agreement of both participating teams, with the home team completing the Game Form.

#### Rearrangement In-Season

- a) Following the Rearrangement Deadline all fixtures are set.
- b) Rearrangements can be made with agreement of both participating teams, the team requesting and making the change will be liable for the £20 fee, which must be paid at the time the <u>Game Form</u> is being submitted. Use Game Code as Reference. The rearranging team is responsible for informing the league by completing the Game Form. A rearrangement is the movement of the date. Failure to inform the league will result in a Rearrangement Fine
- c) If the visiting team has requested a rearrangement, then the home team is to supply two dates for them to choose from. If this is not agreeable, then you are to inform the league and the league will supply a date, with the administration fee of £25 being issued to the appropriate team.
- d) You cannot rearrange a fixture within 72 hours (3 days) of it being scheduled. A <u>Game Form</u> must be completed informing the league of which team will be claiming the game by forfeit.

If a fixture is not played, for whatever reason, and the league has not been informed, both teams are then required to submit a report to the league at <a href="mailto:info@ybl.org.uk">info@ybl.org.uk</a> explaining why, and the league will then take the appropriate action. This could be a default win and a £40.00 fine.

If a team is rearranging a fixture, where officials are appointed by the league, within seven days, the clubs will be responsible for finding two independent referees if the appointed officials are unable to officiate.

#### Team Withdrawal

Before 31 January, all fixtures (and points, if any) shall be deleted from the league. After 31 January fixtures will be awarded to the opposition with a 20-0 win (forfeit).

## Scoresheets & Results

A printable YBL scoresheet is available free of charge from the Officials Admin & Forms page on the website. A running scoresheet is to be used for all YBL fixtures.

A photo of the original scoresheet should be submitted on the day of the fixture or within 48 hours by either email or WhatsApp.

The YBL website will be updated with a result once the scoresheet has been received.

If the scoresheet has not been received 48 hours, the home team will be issued with a £10 fine per-fixture.

If after eight days, the scoresheet has not been received the game will be awarded to the visiting team with a default win.

There will be no email reminders.

## Play-Down Rule

In certain age group leagues/competitions we allow girls to play down a year. Where this is permitted it is displayed in the individual league addendums.

Table standings will be determined on the game points (pts).

In the league standings for any division at U13 or below only the Win/Loss and game points will be displayed.

During the season if teams are on the same points, they will be ranked using baskets scored (F) and then on points difference (+/-) if the same. At the conclusion of the season if teams are on the same points the league standings will be decided by the head-to-head of those teams. If the head-to-head is identical the points will be determined by points difference across those teams.

## Linking to the YBL

The YBL is a league within the BE portal.

All clubs must select the YBL league on their portal.

Create teams and place members (inc. players) participating into those teams for us to check their eligibility during the season. This will also flag any issues that may arise with a licence.

Clubs that have not linked to the YBL will incur an administration charge for any checks that we need to complete regarding eligibility.

## Registrations & Licence Fees

All members, players and coaches must be registered with Basketball England (BE) with the correct licence.

You can register as many players for a team as you wish. All player registrations are covered within the club/team entry fees.

Players must have a 'P' player licence issued by Basketball England and be assigned into a team on their club portal for the YBL to check eligibility. Coaches must have a 'C' coach licence issued by Basketball England and be assigned into a team on their club portal for the YBL to check eligibility. All Team Managers/Game Day Delegates/or Bench Personnel must have the appropriate licence issued by Basketball England and be assigned into a team on their club portal for the YBL to check eligibility.

The YBL does not require any player forms or registrations to be sent to the league, all players, coach, bench (team managers/game day delegates) and staff registrations can be checked on the BE portal.

The exception to this is, the YBL will require a copy of a player licence if they are.

- 1. A player playing in another local league, other than the YBL, (senior only).
- 2. A player is registered national league (all divisions)
- 3. Be informed when a player moves up to NBL and still participating in the YBL  $\,$

## Player Transfers

- a) Club to Club agreement of both clubs and agreement of player/parent/guardian.

- e) We will issue confirmation and move the player to the new club and once received the player may play for their new team.

## Officials

#### Linking to the YBL

All officials MUST link to the YBL or be listed on the program that the YBL uses for appointments.

This is free of charge and can be done at the point of registering for your licence.

Failure to link your profile to the YBL will result in sanctions to both the club and official (where clubs are appointing their own officials).



#### Official's Criteria

All officials must wear appropriate uniform to officiate within the YBL.

That can be a YBL top or a Basketball England top with black trousers and black trainers/basketball shoes.

#### Minimum requirements for officials

All officials to be correctly qualified & licenced with Basketball England

#### Payment of Officials

Is the responsibility of the home club to pay all officials. A guide can be found within the YBL Official's Section on the website.

#### Appointment of Officials

The YBL will appoint referees to the leagues below, unless the home club has opted out of this service, Under 19, Under 21, Under 23, Men2, Men1, Women2, Women1 and YBL events as required.

Official's to find their own replacement if they are unable to do a fixture after they have confirmed.

#### Neutrality

Basketball England rules state that the crew chief must be a neutral L2+ official. The YBL acknowledge that this may not always be possible. If an in-house crew chief is appointed, it must be with the prior agreement of the opposition.

BE rules state that the minimum requirement for each fixture is two table officials and two referees.

#### Appeals, Complaints and Under Protest

<u>i.davies@ybl.org.uk</u> games signed under protest. Remember this must be done within 72 hours of the game and a copy of the scoresheet supplied with a full explanation of your protest. You must also send an administration fee.

A game can only be signed under protest if it meets the following criteria: (a) an error in scorekeeping, timekeeping or shot clock operating (b) a decision to cancel, postpone, to not resume or not play a game (c) a violation of the eligibility rules.

k.accalia@ybl.org.uk any appeal to a decision made by the YBL must be accompanied by an administration fee. Remember you must appeal a decision within 48 hours of the decision being made. Please ensure you provide your written appeal grounds together with any supporting information/evidence.

## In-Game Sanctions

#### Zone & Full Court Press (for all divisions except U15 Primis & Women1)

For Zone Defense being played illegally (in Quarter 2, 4 and Overtime) after a warning.

If a full court press is played when the team has a 10-point (U9, U11 & U13) or 20-point advantage after a warning.

The crew chief can call an 'Official's Time-Out' with the coaches and their co-official will be called to the centre circle and given a verbal warning that they must cease playing zone defense or playing a full court press (whichever applies) and remind them of the potential sanctions.

The coaches will be given a further 30 seconds to reinforce this message with their players.

Once play has resumed following this 'Official's Time-Out' any further infringements of the rule will result in the coach receiving a 'W' technical foul in the first instance.

This will be recorded as a 'W' (not a 'C') on the scoresheet. The opposition will be awarded one free-throw.

Any further infringements of these rules will result in the coach receiving a technical foul (this time recorded as 'C'). The opposition will be awarded one free-throw.

A coach will not be ejected until they have received two recorded C's on a scoresheet. A 'W' recorded technical will not be counted as a ('C'), but the opposing team will still receive the same one free-throw penalty.

If a coach has been ejected due to repeated breaches of these rules the crew chief must inform the league.

#### Discipline

When a coach, team follower, spectators, official or player comes to a game, they come with the intent of participating in the game in good spirit.

Participants will receive an automatic suspension when their points reach (or exceeds) the following thresholds, 15, 30, 40 & 45. The suspension will be for the next scheduled game for that individual.

Points will be reset for each season unless otherwise directed by the Board of Directors in accordance with Basketball England's Disciplinary Code or Rules and Regulations for the current season.

If an incident occurs that is not covered, the BE Code of Conduct can be used.

Financial sanctions will be for players aged 18 and over. Repeat infractions (juniors players exceeding 15 points) will result in clubs being issued financial sanctions on behalf of junior players (at the discretion of the Board of Directors).

Clubs will receive email notification of any in-game sanctions issued. This will be visible in your clubs Secure Page.

Basketball England's Disciplinary Panel/Safeguarding Panel will be informed of all incidents that meet the threshold for referral.

#### In-Game Sanctions

#### Zone & Full Court Press (for all divisions except U15 Primis & Women1)

For Zone Defense being played illegally (in Quarter 2, 4 and Overtime) after a warning. If a full court press is played when the team has a 10-point (U9, U11, U13) or 20-point advantage after a warning.

The crew chief can call an 'Official's Time-Out' with the coaches and their co-official will be called to the centre circle and given a verbal warning that they must cease playing zone defense or playing a full court press (whichever applies) and remind them of the potential sanctions.

The coaches will be given a further 30 seconds to reinforce this message with their players.

Once play has resumed following this 'Official's Time-Out' any further infringements of the rule will result in the coach receiving a 'W' technical foul in the first instance

This will be recorded as a 'W' (not a 'C') on the scoresheet. The opposition will be awarded one free-throw.

Any further infringements of these rules will result in the coach receiving a technical foul (this time recorded as 'C'). The opposition will be awarded one free-throw.

A coach will not be ejected until they have received two recorded C's on a scoresheet. A 'W' recorded technical will not be counted as a ('C'), but the opposing team will still receive the same one free-throw penalty.

## YBL Full Court Press Rule - U15+ divisions (except Women 1 & U15 Primis)

When a team have obtained a 20-point lead, they MUST play half-court defence. Teams can attempt to rebound, however once the opposition has secured clear possession/control of the ball (including dribbling in their own back court), the other team MUST return into their own half (three-point line extended) and may play defence once the ball is in their defensive back court.
